MTC OFFICER ELECTION REQUIREMENTS

Students who would like to run for MTC office for must be in good standing with all requirements below.

- 1. Must be a member of Thespian Society or qualified to be inducted at the banquet (10 points)
- 2. Must be nominated by a current member at the nomination meeting.
- 3. Can't have lost UIL eligibility more than two times in one year.
- 4. Freshmen can run for office (not president) only if they have 10 Thespian points and are inducted at the Banquet, if elections are held at the end of the school year. If elections are held at the beginning of the school year a letter or email of recommendation from their jr. high theatre teacher is required.
- 5. Must have a passing average.
- 6. Can't have dropped or have been removed from a show.
- 7. Can't have had multiple days of ISS, Alternative School or have been suspended.
- 8. All nominees must sign and have their parents sign the MTC officer handbook acknowledgment form. ONLY current members of Thespians can nominate or 2nd a person. NON-Thespian members can vote but only if they are eligible to be inducted at the banquet, elections are taking place at the end of the year. If elections are taking place at the beginning of the year all freshmen MTC members can vote but not nominate.
